Grade 4-8 A La Carte Course Descriptions:

Code	Course Descriptions	Course Description
TH3	Theater, Dance and Song Teacher: Tess McKinley	This class introduces students to basic theater skills through the use of theater games, improvisation, and warm-up techniques. We will learn some of the songs from America's great musicals with simple staging and choreography as well as learning some folk and ballroom dancing. This class helps students to engage creatively with text, use performance and public speaking skills, and move fluidly and expressively while gaining an appreciation for the performing arts.
TH4	A Christmas Carol Rehearsal and Performance Teacher: Tess McKinley	Students will be cast as characters in Charles Dickens' classic story <i>A Christmas Carol</i> . Using simple staging with minimal props or costumes, our focus will be on characterization and storytelling. We will present our work for an invited audience at the conclusion of our 8-week session. Parents, grandparents, and older siblings may also participate for no additional fee.
MU3	Singing Class/ General Music/ Chorus Teacher Chris Hartford	Students will learn American Folk Songs and more advanced repertoire through listening, singing, beat-keeping, movement, solfege (do, re, mi) and games. Students will listen to classical/jazz/musicals and learn basic Music History. Students will sing secular and sacred choral music.
MU4	Singing Class/ General Music/ Chorus Teacher Chris Hartford	This is a continuation of Term I where students will learn American Folk Songs and more advanced repertoire through listening, singing, beat-keeping, movement, solfege (do, re, mi) and games. Students will listen to classical/jazz/musicals and learn basic Music History. Students will sing secular and sacred choral music. There will be a focus on Christmas music, culminating in a candlelit caroling service.
