We will also learn simple circle and folk dances.	
TH2	Continuation of Introduction to Theater I: Games, Stories, Songs and Dances Teacher: Tess McKinley	Students will learn theater exercises for voice, body, and imagination and enact simple stagings using <i>Grimm's Fairy Tales</i> . They will engage imaginatively with dance and movement using musical rhythms and non-verbal storytelling through exploration of Saint-Saens' <i>The Carnival of Animals</i> and oral expression using "Call Up Your Courage" from the <i>Aeneid</i> . We will also learn simple circle and folk dances.
